April's Story

"When I became pregnant, I thought it was impossible. I was jobless, single, and I was scared to death. Several people suggested I should have an abortion, so thinking there was nothing else I could do, I drove to the abortion clinic carrying a heavy weight on my shoulders. Inside I was desperate for a miracle.

"And a miracle happened. As I pulled into the parking lot, a man waved down my car and gave me directions to the Life Centers nearby instead.

"At Life Centers I spoke to a peer counselor who showed me what a growing fetus looked like, talked about the heartbeat, and explained my options. She was the first person to actually share joy in this difficult situation in my life. She gave me a big hug and told me that Life Centers would help in any way they could with material and emotional support. It gave me chills. The most amazing feeling swept over me. The people at the center were so full of life and were spending their own personal time to help me and save my child.

"After choosing life, I eventually began talking to God, reading my Bible, and I embraced forgiveness. I enrolled in college with a major in nursing.

"If it had not been for the kindness of those at Life Centers, my story would have been severely different. Instead, my son is alive, and I thank God for the miracles he has done!"

At Life Centers We *witness miracles* - extraordinary events accomplished through God's power.

In this report you'll see numbers, updates, and accounts of lives saved and transformed. Each miracle story in the life of a woman who experienced an unplanned pregnancy, or the miracle of an unborn child saved, points to a bigger story: God's love for us demonstrated through Jesus Christ.

This 2010 annual report shares miracle highlights from the year, both individual and corporate. We praise God for lives saved, souls won, services provided, new centers added, increased ministry awareness, and strengthened partnerships.

As new miracles take place, our focus remains the same: proclaiming the gospel to women in unplanned pregnancies and protecting the unborn for God's glory. In 2010, Life Centers provided 23,740 free services (pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, peer counseling, 24-hour Help Line calls, post-abortion healing groups, gospel outreach, maternity and support services) to over 7,635 women in Central Indiana.

As a result, 329 women who were considering abortion instead chose life for their babies, and 723 women and family members chose life in Christ! We thank God and give him all the glory.

We celebrate the many miracles of 2010 which reveal that God is at work on behalf of vulnerable women in unplanned pregnancies and their innocent unborn children. We thank those who pray, serve, give and partner with Life Centers in the mission to save souls and lives.

Miracle of ...growth

Life Centers welcomed 43rd President of the United States George W. Bush to Conseco Fieldhouse in Indianapolis on April 15, 2010, for the 27th Annual Celebration of Life. More than 3,500 people gathered to lift up the Lord Jesus Christ and celebrate lives saved at this special event.

It was an honor to host President Bush, who credited Jesus Christ as his hero and the Almighty as his strength. He gave a “verbal tour” of the Oval Office and exhorted the audience to continue demonstrating love through the Life Centers ministry.

President Bush’s stories gave us insight into life in and out of the White House. He inspired the crowd with tales about his travels, interactions with world leaders, and the challenges he faced. President Bush said that despite the pressures of the office, “Every day was joyous, and I believe it was because of the prayer of fellow citizens.”

Life Centers president and CEO Brian Boone had the privilege of interviewing and praying with President Bush, thanking the Lord for Bush’s stance for life and asking blessings on him for the journey forward.

Sandi Patty shared her story of adoption and personal appreciation for the Life Centers ministry. She and 2009 Miss America Katie Stam sang with the Heritage Christian High School Colla Voce Choir, providing worshipful music for the event. Congressman Mike Pence and Indianapolis Colts coaches Jim Caldwell and Clyde Christensen shared words of challenge and affirmation with the pastors, sponsors, and supporters in attendance.

Many new community sponsorships and partnerships developed as a result of this event. Life Centers gives glory to God for the largest attendance yet for a Celebration of Life event and thanks the Lord for the lives and souls that will be impacted for eternity as a result.

Avon Pregnancy Center

In January 2010, Life Centers opened a new Avon Pregnancy Center located at 107 Park Place Boulevard in Avon. Life Centers previously operated a center in Avon that served thousands of Hendricks County women until that building closed in 2006 with the anticipation of relocation. Leasing space within the Kingsway Community Care Center, a distinct nonprofit organization which offers medical services to an underserved population, provides a natural partnership. This location provides easy access to Highway 36. Life Centers held an open house on February 28, 2010, to educate the community about the new services offered.



Westfield Pregnancy Center

In September 2010, Life Centers announced the opening of a ninth location. The new space, located at 140 S. Cherry Street in Westfield, occupies the same building as the Center for Women's Ministries, a nonprofit organization which offers counseling services and clothing at reduced prices. The location provides a private and comfortable setting with close proximity to local schools and easy access to U.S. 31 and Highway 32. Life Centers previously operated a center in Hamilton County until that building closed in 2008 with the anticipation of relocation. Community members, supporters and the Westfield Mayor attended an open house on November 14, 2010.

Kelli's Story

"It was my first time being pregnant, and I was so in shock. **My family didn't approve. The father of the baby wanted me to have an abortion. I was overwhelmed with a lot of worry.** I was thinking, 'What if this, what if that?' I had no place to stay, and hardly anything to eat. **It really hurt** — I didn't have anyone. I thought nobody cared.

"Kathy, my Life Centers peer counselor, prayed with me and calmed me down. I didn't feel like I was being judged, when everyone else in my life was judging me. It was the first positive thing and person in my life.

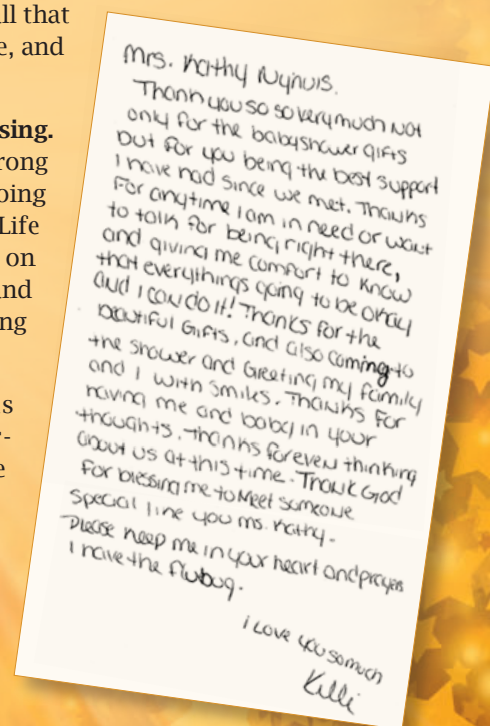
"She told me about all of my options beside abortion. **We went into the ultrasound room and I saw it. I knew then that I couldn't have an abortion.** [Life Centers] really changed my

decision. It really changed me. **I had never read the Bible, but Life Centers gave me a Bible I could understand.**

"In October I got saved and was baptized. I used to smoke, drink, all that stuff. I wanted to change, and my heart was ready.

"This baby is a blessing. I was going down the wrong road, but now I'm going down the right road. Life Centers supporters put on a baby shower for me, and I've never had anything like that before.

"Finding out I was pregnant was overwhelming, but there were people at Life Centers that wanted to do things to help. I really appreciate Life Centers."

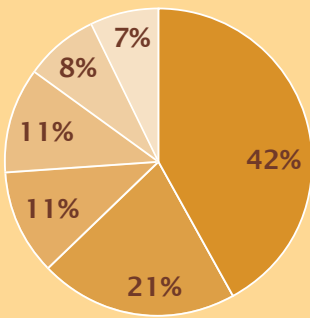

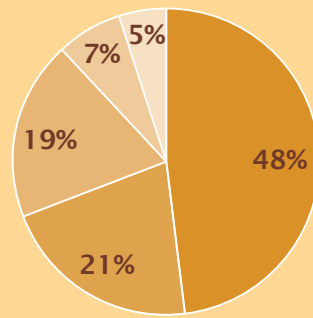
Total Income: \$1,747,122

Total Expenses: \$1,865,435



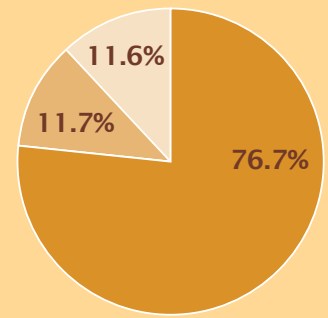
Income by Source
