

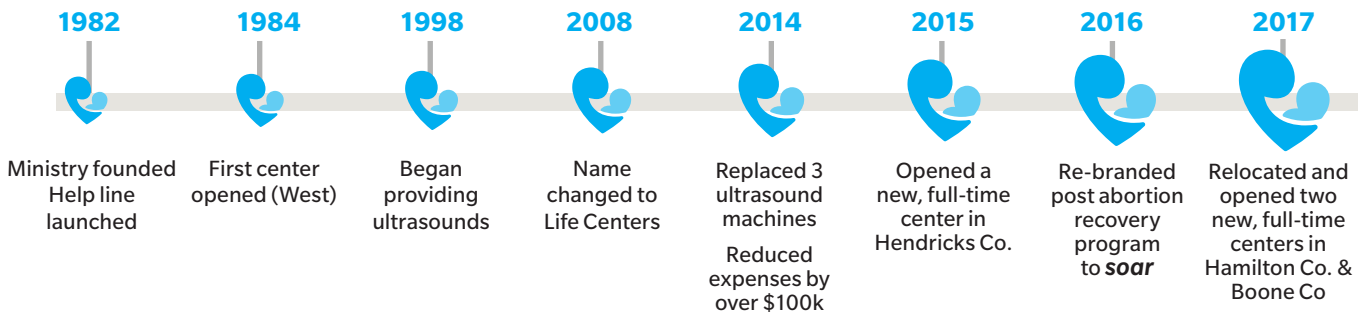
## Vision, Mission, and Values

**Our Key Distinction:**

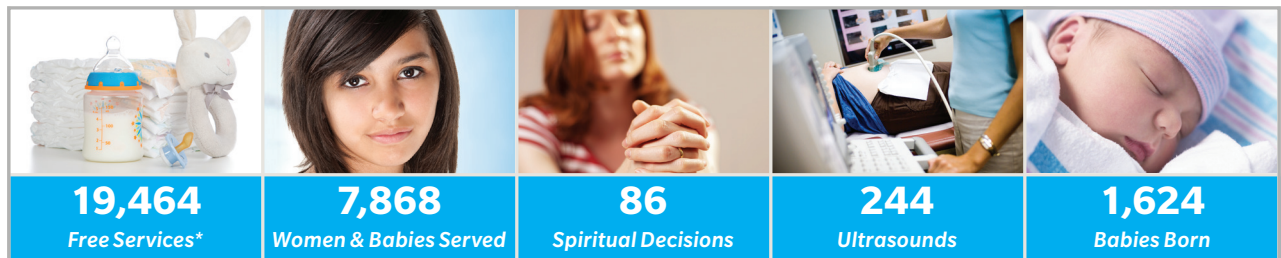
- We emphasize the gospel and biblical principles in our counseling sessions

- Our eight centers are strategically located where the need is the greatest
- Life Centers has been the only faith based Pregnancy Resource Center in greater Indianapolis since 1984

## Engagement Model

- Staff: center directors, associate center directors, medical team, leadership and administration staff
- Center volunteers: peer counselors, sonographers, receptionists, 24 hour help
- Non-center volunteers: Life Ambassadors (ensure engagement with local churches), prayer intercessors

## Ministry Results in 2017

- Relocated and opened two new, full-time centers in Hamilton Co. & Boone Co.
- Broadened our services to our clients by adding referral STI testing
- A recent financial review conducted by an independent firm reflected our ministry is healthy and strong, we continue to stay under budget while maintaining a healthy reserve balance

## Life Centers' Future Strategies

- Increase outreach to the communities where English is not the first language
- Continue to broaden post-abortive recovery programs in and out of the church
- Diversify fundraising events beyond our annual Celebration of Life banquet
- Launch new initiatives for clients such as parenting, cooking and bible study classes
- Continued focus on building and growing our ministry partners such as adoption agencies, Wheeler Mission and Shepherd Community Center.

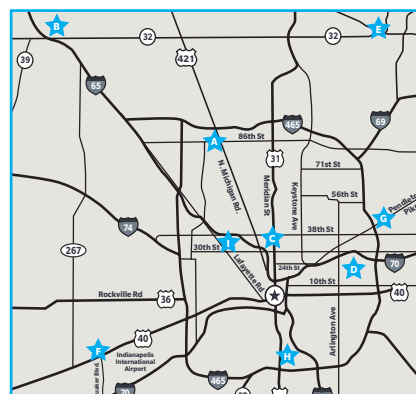

## Current Ministry Needs:

- Funding to cover the cost of our medical liability insurance (\$10,000)
